

On March 7, 2018, as his fellow Legionnaires and brothers in arms, members of the Joe Dominguez American Legion Post #742 Honor Guard participated in providing military honors for Corona's Marcello Arguelles at Riverside National Cemetery. Marcello was a longtime member of our post and a World War II Army Veteran who fought in the Battle of the Bulge. Marcello was wounded by mortar rounds during the battle for which he was awarded the Purple Heart medal.

Marcello was also a member of our Post's Honor Guard and is depicted in the honor guard photograph (circa 1950's) that was taken in front of St. Edward's Catholic Church. Our brother is now at rest and in endless
